To this day, no one has succeeded in crossing the Arctic Ocean single-handed and without assistance

An ambitious project

2000km single-handed, across immense glaciers from the Arkticheski Cape in Siberia to Ward Hunt in Canada, Georges Baumann will set off pulling his sledge behind him facing extreme temperatures of -60 degrees

and the danger of the perpetually moving ice. The start of this adventure is fixed for between the 6th and 15th February and scheduled to finish around the end of May 2006.

A taste for freedom
